Action in the Community Environment

Helping people to help themselves

ACE Africa provides support to orphans and vulnerable children and their families in East Africa who are infected and affected by HIV and AIDS.

- ACE Africa works in three rural areas in Kenya and Tanzania where HIV/AIDS and poverty are rife and over 20% of children are orphaned.
- ACE Africa believes children infected and affected by HIV and AIDS should be cared for and supported within their own communities in a culturally relevant manner.
- ACE Africa empowers community members to care for vulnerable children themselves through training in food, nutrition and economic security, health education and the protection of rights and wellbeing and education services.
- The ACE Africa unique, low cost and sustainable approach is recognised as a leading 'best practice model' in Western Kenya and is being developed to be adapted and replicated elsewhere in Sub Sahara Africa
- ACE Africa works with over 4,000 community volunteers, has reached 400,000 vulnerable children and their families since 2004 at an average cost of £2 per head.



Out of 700 charities, ACE Africa was the 2010 STARS Foundation Impact Award recipient for excellence in community health projects

How can you help change a child's life?

It doesn't cost much to give a lot:

- £1 provides a child with a pair of flipflops
- £5 provides a treated mosquito net for a vulnerable household
- £20 provides a full school uniform & shoes for one child
- £40 provides one meal a day for a family of 5 for a month
- £60 provides medicine for a person living with AIDS for a year
- £300 provides a month's wages for an HIV counsellor in Kenya
- £380 provides an orphan with secondary school education for a year



Friends of ACE – become a Regular Giver

A little amount in Africa goes a long way. You can help ACE Africa's work by donating even a small amount. Standing orders are the most cost-effective donations and help us to plan ahead. ACE Africa Bursary Programme - Sponsor a child's secondary school education

The ACE Africa Bursary Programme began in 2005 in response to the lack of educational support for orphans in Bungoma, Kenya. The programme provides funding for secondary education at boarding school for orphans from the most disadvantaged families. In October every year, we appeal to new sponsors ahead of the next school year intake in January 2012. The subscription is £380 (plus Gift Aid) annually and is a 4 year commitment. Sponsors are able to correspond directly with their child.

2013 Climbing for Children or Building for Change

In January 2013, ACE Africa is partnering again with 'Destiny of a Child' on an exciting fundraising challenge in Tanzania 'Climbing for Children and Building for Change'. Choose whether to climb Mount Kilimanjaro or in teams of six help to build six new classrooms and kitchen gardens at schools near Arusha, Tanzania.
